

Notice of the Making of a Definitive Map Modification Order, North Yorkshire County Council, Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981, The Eastern Part of the County of the Former North Riding of Yorkshire, Definitive Map and Statement, Public Footpath Nos. 30.19/34, 30.19/35, 30.19/36 & 30.19/37, Weaponness Valley Close and Oriel Close to Queen Margaret's Road and Seamer Road, Scarborough, Modification Order 2019

The above Order, made on 28/11/19, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding the following four footpaths, all as shown on the Order Plan:

Footpath 30.19/34, commencing at the southern end of Oriel Close at Grid Reference TA 0358 8716 and running south-west along a snicket for approximately 47 metres to TA 0355 8713, then generally south-west across a field for approximately 162 metres to TA 0345 8701, then generally south for approximately 278 metres, entering the Industrial Estate at TA 0341 8674, continuing south along a footway for approximately 357 metres to join Queen Margaret's Road opposite The Mere at TA 0345 8644. **Footpath 30.19/35**, commencing at its junction with Footpath 30.19/34 at TA 0339 8646, and running generally west along an access road for approximately 48 metres to TA 0335 8645, then south for approximately 14 metres, climbing a flight of steps to its junction with Queen Margaret's Road at TA 0335 8643. **Footpath 30.19/36**, commencing at its junction with Weaponness Valley Close at TA 0352 8716 and running generally south-west for approximately 21 metres to a stile at TA 0351 8714, then generally south-south-west for approximately 104 metres to its junction with Footpath 30.19/34 in the field at TA 0347 8704. **Footpath 30.19/37**, Commencing at its junction with Footpath 30.19/34 at TA 0344 8699 and running west for approximately 93 metres to TA 0334 8699, then south-south-west for approximately 31 metres to TA 0332 8697, then west for approximately 70 metres to its junction with Seamer Road at TA 0326 8697. Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Andrew Hunter, Definitive Map Team, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD, no later than 26/03/20, stating the grounds on which it is made. Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination. If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Yorkshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State or part of it if the Authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 may itself confirm the Order or that part of the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This order is made by North Yorkshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Eastern Part of the County of the Former North Riding of Yorkshire Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i), namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. North Yorkshire County Council hereby order that:-

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 5 November 2019.
2. The Eastern Part of the County of the Former North Riding of Yorkshire Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Public Footpath Nos. 30.19/34, 30.19/35, 30.19/36 & 30.19/37, Weaponness Valley Close and Oriel Close to Queen Margaret's Road and Seamer Road, Scarborough Modification Order 2019.

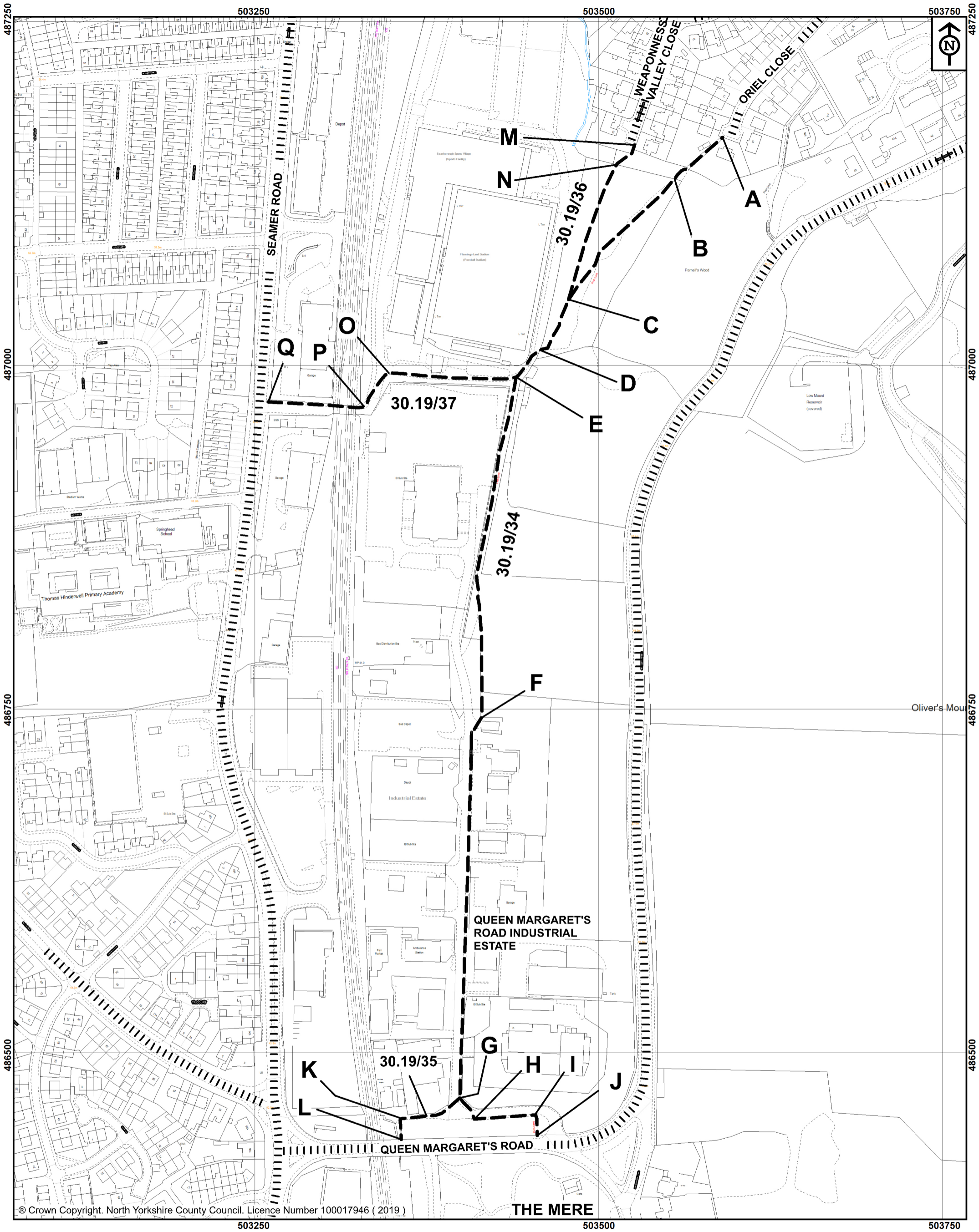
