

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT FOR ACCESS) (POCKLEY MOOR)  
ORDER 2009

North Yorkshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the roads specified below and shown on the map attached to this Order:-

ROADS IN THE PARISHES OF BRANSDALE, NAWTON AND POCKLEY

- (a) U64, from Birk Nab Farm northwards to its junction with the U74 at Hanging Stone; and
  - (b) U74, from the gate at OS Grid Reference SE 463259 490760 northwards to its junction with the U28, Helmsley to Cockayne road.
2. Nothing in article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any motor vehicle to proceed along any road therein specified if the vehicle is being used:-
    - (a) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
    - (b) (i) in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that road or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in that road or in land accessible only from that road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line or telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
    - (ii) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties;
    - (iii) for the purposes of agriculture, land management or shooting on any land or premises adjacent to that road,


and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on 16 March 2009 and may be cited as "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Except for Access) (Pockley Moor) Order 2009".



Area 4 Kirkbymoorside**


