Notice of making of a Public Path Diversion Order Highways Act 1980 North Yorkshire County Council Public Footpath Nos. 35.33/2 & 35.33/3, Healaugh Grange, Healaugh. Diversion Order 2022

The above Order, made on 4.11.2022, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert the Public Footpaths described as: Public Footpath No 35.33/2 between GR SE 4893 4842 and GR SE 4898 4871, will be diverted onto a new line between GR SE 4890 4844 and GR SE 4898 4871. Public Footpath No. 35.33/3 between GR SE 4897 4863 and GR SE 4914 4859 will be diverted onto a new line between GR SE 4898 4871 and GR SE 4914 4859.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Tadcaster Community Library, 6-8 Station Road, Tadcaster, North Yorkshire until 22.12.2022. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to Claire Phillips at the above address not later than 22.12.2022. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination. If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Yorkshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

DIVERSION ORDER 2022

This Order is made by North Yorkshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner(s) of the land crossed by the Public Footpaths described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Path(s) should be diverted.

Mr A Lister of Healaugh Grange, Healaugh, Tadcaster has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the Path(s) into a fit condition for use by the public.

Selby District Council and Healaugh Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Healaugh Grange, Healaugh and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall from the date of the above mentioned certification be the Public Footpaths over the land situated at Healaugh Grange, Healaugh described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

Starting at Grid Reference 44893 44842 (Point A) at the end of the driveway to Healaugh Grange, and running generally north for approximately 217 metres, through the farm yard, to Grid Reference 44897 44863 (Point B) and then continuing north and then north east for approximately 76 metres to Grid Reference 44898 44871 (Point C).	0.9 metres
<u>Section of Footpath as shown on the attached map</u>	<u>Position</u>	<u>Width</u>
Public Footpath No. 35.33/3, as marked with a bold continuous line (B-D) on the attached plan.	Starting at Grid Reference 44897 44863 (Point B) in Healaugh Grange's farm yard, and running generally east, then south east for approximately 194 metres to Grid Reference 44914 44859 (Point D).	0.9 metres

Starting at Grid Reference 44890 44844 (Point E), on Bridleway No. 35.33/1 and running north north east for approximately 5 metres to a gap in the hedge at Grid Reference 44891 44844 (Point F) and then continuing north north east, along the headland of an arable field for approximately 283 metres to Grid Reference 44895 44872 (Point G) and then running south east for approximately 36 metres to Grid Reference 44898 44871 (Point C), to the north of Healaugh Grange's farm yard. Total length of approximately 324 metres on a grass surface.	2 metres
<u>Section of Footpath as shown on the attached map</u>	<u>Position</u>	<u>Width</u>
Public Footpath No. 35.33/3 as marked with a bold dashed line (C-H-I-D) on the attached plan.	Starting at Grid Reference 44898 44871 (Point C), to the north of Healaugh Grange's farm yard and running generally south east for approximately 116 metres, following the headland of an arable field and alongside farm buildings, to Grid Reference 44909 44867 (Point H) and then continuing east south east for approximately 68 metres to Grid Reference 44915 44865 (Point I), and then continuing generally south for approximately 57 metres to Grid Reference 44914 44859 (Point D), to the south east of farm buildings. Total length of 241 metres on a grass surface.	2 metres

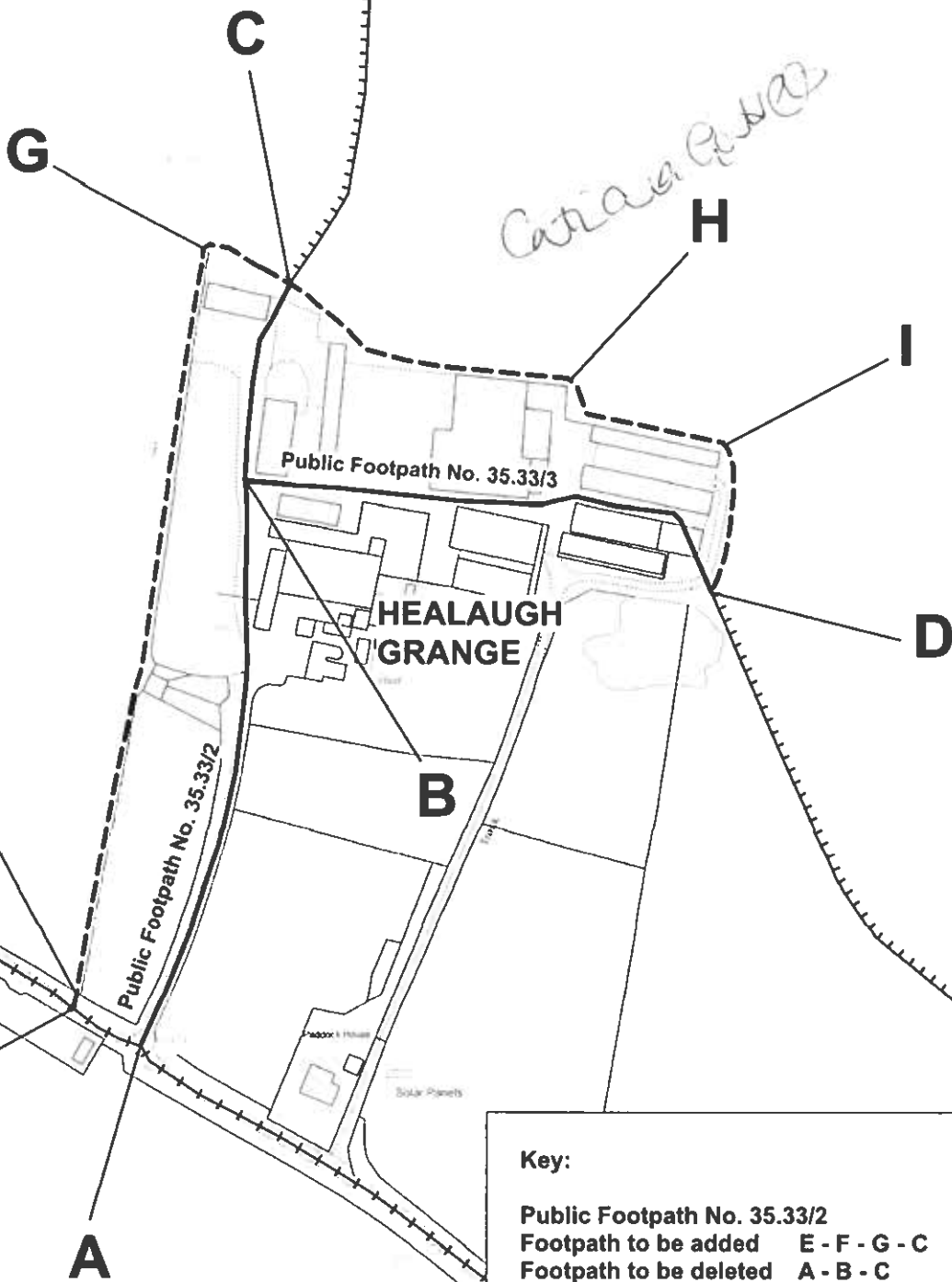
