

**NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)**  
**(DISTRICT OF HAMBLETON)**  
**(AMENDMENT NO TBC) ORDER 2021**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that North Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Hambleton) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

Alne	Jack Hole	South	Its junction with Church Wind westwards for a distance of 26.5 metres.	No Waiting at any Time
Alne	C98 Church Wind	West	Its junction with Jack Hole southwards for a distance of 28 metres	No Waiting at any Time
Alne	C98 Main Street/ C98 Church Wind	South/East	The western end of the layby on Main Street westwards and then southwards for a distance of 49 metres.	No Waiting at any Time
