

**NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING EXCEPT FOR ACCESS) (VARIOUS ROADS, WHITBY  
SWING BRIDGE, WHITBY) EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC ORDER 2021**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 26 03 2021 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from proceeding along those lengths of road described in Schedule A, below, except for those circumstances detailed in the said Order.

**SCHEDULE A**

Grape Lane, Whitby, from its junction with Bridge Street to its junction with Church Street – Restriction: Pedestrian zone, 10.30am to 4pm; Bridge Street, Whitby, from the western end of the swing bridge to the eastern end of the swing bridge – Restriction: no vehicles Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays 10.30am to 4pm; St. Ann's Staith, Whitby, from its junction with New Quay Road to its junction with Hagersgate – Restriction: no motor vehicles except for loading, buses, taxis and permit holders 10.30am to 4pm; Hagersgate, Whitby, from its junction with St Ann's Staith to its junction with Pier Road – Restriction: no motor vehicles except for loading, buses, taxis and permit holders 10.30am to 4pm; Piers Road, Whitby, from its junction with Hagersgate to its junction with Khyber Pass – Restriction: no motor vehicles except for loading buses, taxis and permit holders 10.30am – 4pm; Khyber Pass, Whitby, from its junction with Pier Road to its junction with Cliff Street – Restriction: no motor vehicles except for loading, buses, taxis and permit holders 10.30am to 4pm.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 10 04 2021, together with a map showing the roads affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton, during normal office hours between 01 04 2021 and 09 10 2022 and also available to be viewed online at [www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map](http://www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map) or <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders>. The County Council will be considering, in due course, whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months from the coming into force of the Order, or if the Order is subsequently varied or modified, from the coming into operation of that variation or modification (whichever is the later), any person may object to the making of an Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation.

Any person wishing to object to the indefinite continuation of the Order must state the grounds for their objection, in writing, addressed to Area 3 Whitby Office, Whitby Highways Depot, Cholmley Way, Whitby YO22 4NQ or by email to [area3.whitby@northyorks.gov.uk](mailto:area3.whitby@northyorks.gov.uk) or via the website link by 09 10 2022.

If you wish to question the validity of the above Experimental Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 26 03 2021 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
