Note that the County Council does not charge VAT on licences, except where stated below; however, if the company you are dealing with is VAT registered, they are required to charge you VAT at the standard rate for both the licence and any associated administrative charges.

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| Temporary excavation in the Highway (s171 HA) and licence to place and maintain/repair apparatus in the Highway (s50 NRSWA) | £331 (£181 licence fee plus £150 inspection fee (£50 x 3 inspections)) |
| Building materials licence | £72 for a 2 week licence. |
| Highway projection licence | £144 licence fee (fee only applies to new projections). |
| Cellar opening licence | Officer time spent dealing with cellar opening applications is charged at an hourly rate of £44.00 per hour and any other external costs incurred by the County Council are recharged to the applicant. |
| Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders | 18 month closure - £442 (plus advertising at cost). |
| | 5 day closure - £331. |
| | Emergency closure - £331. |
| | Event closure - £331 for a new event and £166 for a recurring event (plus advertising at cost). |
| | Registered charitable events and not-for profit events are exempt from the fee, but advertising costs may still apply. Additional charges will be applied where further work is required in relation to a temporary closure at an hourly rate of £44.00 per hour. |
| Vehicular Crossings (dropped kerbs) | £99 with planning permission. |

| Road safety audits | £44 per hour plus mileage costs +VAT . Audits vary in size so difficult to quote an approximate figure. Estimate will be provided on request. |

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| Rechargeable works admin fee | <p>Requested and Damage works Work costs <£500 minimum charge of £50. Work costs £500 - £1,000 minimum charge of £100. Work costs >£1,000 admin fee 20% of total.</p> |
| Mobile mechanical plant machinery e.g. cherry picker, scissor lifts and cranes (one day or less) | There is no charge for mobile mechanical plant machinery that is on site for one day or less. |

| Stopping up order | <p>Officer time spent dealing with an application will be charged at an hourly rate of £44.00 per hour.</p> <p>Other external costs incurred by the County Council will be recharged to the applicant.</p> <p>The applicant must pay a fee of £828.00 with the initial request and the balance must be settled prior to the application to the Magistrates Court.</p> |
| H-Bar Markings | <p>£221.00 total fee.</p> <p>Please note Blue Badge holders are exempt from the charge.</p> |
| Request from consultants / private companies for 'new' information | <p>Officer time spent preparing 'new' information requested by consultants / private companies will be charged at an hourly rate of £44.00 per hour.</p> <p>Existing information will be provided in accordance with the County Council Publication Scheme, which states that as much information as possible should be made available free of charge.</p> <p>Information will be provided on receipt of payment.</p> |
| Structures approval | <p>Officer time spent assessing new structures proposed by developers will be charged at an hourly rate of £44.00 per hour.</p> <p>The applicant must pay a fee of £110.00 with the initial request and the balance must be settled with the request for signature of the Approval in Principle (AIP).</p> |

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| Abnormal loads notification | <p>There is no charge for processing the notifications or indemnities. However, charges will be made for other services including: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If calculations are required to determine if the bridge (or other structure) is suitable to carry the abnormal load. • If any street furniture is required to be removed (and replaced) in order for the movement to take place. |
| Traffic speed and flow data (where available) | £52 per site (+£44 per hour or part hour) ∴ Basic request = £96 +VAT. Where non-standard reports are requested this fee will increase. Applicants will be notified prior to charges. Where the request is received from a member of the public and is straightforward the fee may be waived. |
| Turning-off (or Bagging-off) of traffic signal lights (including pedestrian crossing lights) | This MUST be arranged in advance with the North Yorkshire County Council Traffic Engineering Team (traffic.signals@northyorks.gov.uk) and will be charged dependent upon dates, times and durations, but is likely to be in the region of £500. |
| Application from developer for a Traffic Regulation Order amendment | Officer time spent dealing with an application from a developer for a Traffic Regulation Order amendment is charged at an hourly rate of £44.00 per hour and other external costs incurred by the County Council are recharged to the applicant. |
| Over-sail of the highway by crane and cable spanning the highway applications | £144 licence fee |
| Officer time spent dealing with requests for commercial events on the highway | Officer time will be charged at an hourly rate of £44.00 but registered charitable events, not-for profit events and events where the County Council is a delivery partner are exempt from the fee. |
| Officer time spent dealing with applications from external organisations to carry out traffic surveys on the public highway | Officer time will be charged at an hourly rate of £44.00 |
