(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(DISTRICT OF SELBY)
ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that on 13 11 2020 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Selby) Consolidation Order 2013" by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedule below:-

SCHEDULE
THROUGH TRAFFIC PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES WITH EXEMPTIONS

Layby on the A162, Brotherton – East (South bound Traffic) from a point 58.5 metres south of the Dish Hill Roundabout (A162) to a point 99.5 metres south of the Dish Hill Roundabout (A162);
Layby on the A162, Brotherton – West (North bound Traffic) from a point 232.5 metres south of the Dish Hill Roundabout (A162) to a point 335.5 metres south of the Dish Hill Roundabout (A162).

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 13 11 2020 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
