

## NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

### **(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (ROADS LEADING TO A66(T))** **ORDER 2020**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 21 July 2020 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

#### Description of Roads Affected

<b>Road</b>	<b>Length</b>
Dick Scot Lane	From its junction with the A66(T) southwards for a distance of 150 metres
Collier Lane	From its junction with the A66 (T) northwards for a distance of 206 metres
Waitlands Lane	From its junction with the A66 (T) southwards to a point 25 metres south of its junction with the centre line of the vehicular access to 'Green Bank Farm'
New Lane	From its junction with the A66 (T) southwards for a distance of 90 metres
Moor Lane	From its junction with the A66 (T) northwards for a distance of 130 metres
Warrener Lane	From its junction with the A66 (T) southwards for 56 metres
