ORDER 2013 (AMENDMENT NO 40) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that North Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Harrogate, Knaresborough, Pannal and Burn Bridge) (Parking and Waiting) (Amendment No 16) Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

Knaresborough	Ash Tree Road	South east	A point 10 metres south west of the entrance to the doctors (Beech House) Surgery	A point 10 metres north east of the entrance to the doctors (Beech House) Surgery	No waiting at any time
Knaresborough	Ash Tree Road	South east	A point 10 metres north east of the entrance to the Doctors Surgery (Beech House Surgery)	The junction of Stockwell Road	No waiting Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm
