(PROHIBITION OF HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN EXCESS OF 7.5 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT EXCEPT FOR ACCESS) (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE DALTON/SESSAY AREA)
ORDER 2020

North Yorkshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order.

PART 1 - GENERAL

1. This Order shall come into operation on **30 November 2020** and may be cited as "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles In Excess of 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight Except for Access) (Various roads in the Dalton/Sessay Area) Order 2020".
2. In this Order "heavy commercial vehicle" means any goods vehicle which has an operating weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes.
3. The Council is satisfied that:-
 - (i) For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
 - (ii) For preventing damage to the road or to any building on or near the road.
 - (iii) For preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which (or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which) is unsuitable, having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property

it is requisite that Section 3(1)(b) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order.

PART 2 - RESTRICTIONS ON HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES

4. Save as provided in article 5 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform use or cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle to proceed in either direction along the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
5. (1) Nothing in article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any heavy commercial vehicle to proceed along the length of road specified in article 4 if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the purposes of access to or from any premises on or adjacent to that road or length of road,
 - (b) for the purposes of agriculture on any land adjacent to that road or length of road or for or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon any such land, or
 - (c) in connection with the carrying out of any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building industrial or demolition operations,
 - (ii) the removal of obstructions to traffic,
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any road,
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or in land adjacent to any road of any sewer or any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the

supply of water, gas or electricity or of any electronic communications network or electronic communications service as defined in Schedule 3A and Section 32 of the Communications Act 2003,

- (d) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes,
- (e) to proceed to or from any premises at which the vehicle on that occasion is to be or has been garaged, serviced or repaired,
- (f) in the service of a Local Authority or Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties of that Authority,
- (g) for the purpose of access to or from any premises on or adjacent to any other public road which has a junction with the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order and that premises or land can only be accessed by means of the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

(2) In this article any reference to premises or land is a reference to premises or land, in whole or in part, to which access for heavy commercial vehicles for any of the purposes specified in article 5(1) of this Order can be obtained by means only of a road specified or referred to in article 4 of this Order and any reference to the carrying out of any operations is a reference to the carrying out of such operations on any premises, land or road specified in article 5(1) of this Order.

6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

C168, Moor End Lane/ Sandy Lane/ Islebeck Lane/ Willow Bridge Lane	1 From its junction with the southern side of the unclassified road which passes to the south of Low Moor Farm and leads to the A19, south westwards to its junction with the C99 in Dalton Village
Unclassified road Water Lane Dalton	2 For its entire length
Unclassified road Back Lane Dalton	3 For its entire length
Unclassified road Village Street Dalton	4 For its entire length
C99, Dalton Lane/Low Lane	5 From a point 767 metres east of its junction with Eldmire Lane eastwards through Dalton, Little Hutton and Hutton Sessay to the A19
Unclassified road Church Lane	6 From its junction with the C99, Low Lane in Hutton Sessay south westwards to its junction with the C179 Race Lane at Little Sessay
C179 Race Lane	7 From its junction with the C99 at Little Hutton southwards through Sessay and Little Sessay to its junction with the C86 near Thornton Bridge
Unclassified road Eldmire Lane/Ox Close Lane/ Blind Piece Lane	8 From a point immediately south of its junction with the vehicular access to Dalton Industrial Estate eastwards to its junction with the C99 at Dalton Moor
Unclassified Loop Road to the south of	9 For its entire length from its junction with Eldmire Lane to its junction with Blind Piece Lane

Ox Close Lane		
Unclassified road Hutton Rae Lane	10	From its junction with the A19 south westwards to its junction with the C99 Low Lane
Unclassified road Moor Lane	11	From its junction with the A19 westwards to its junction with the C168 Sandy Lane
Unclassified road Fawdington Road	12	For its entire length
Unclassified road linking Blind Piece Lane and the C179 Race Lane	13	For its entire length

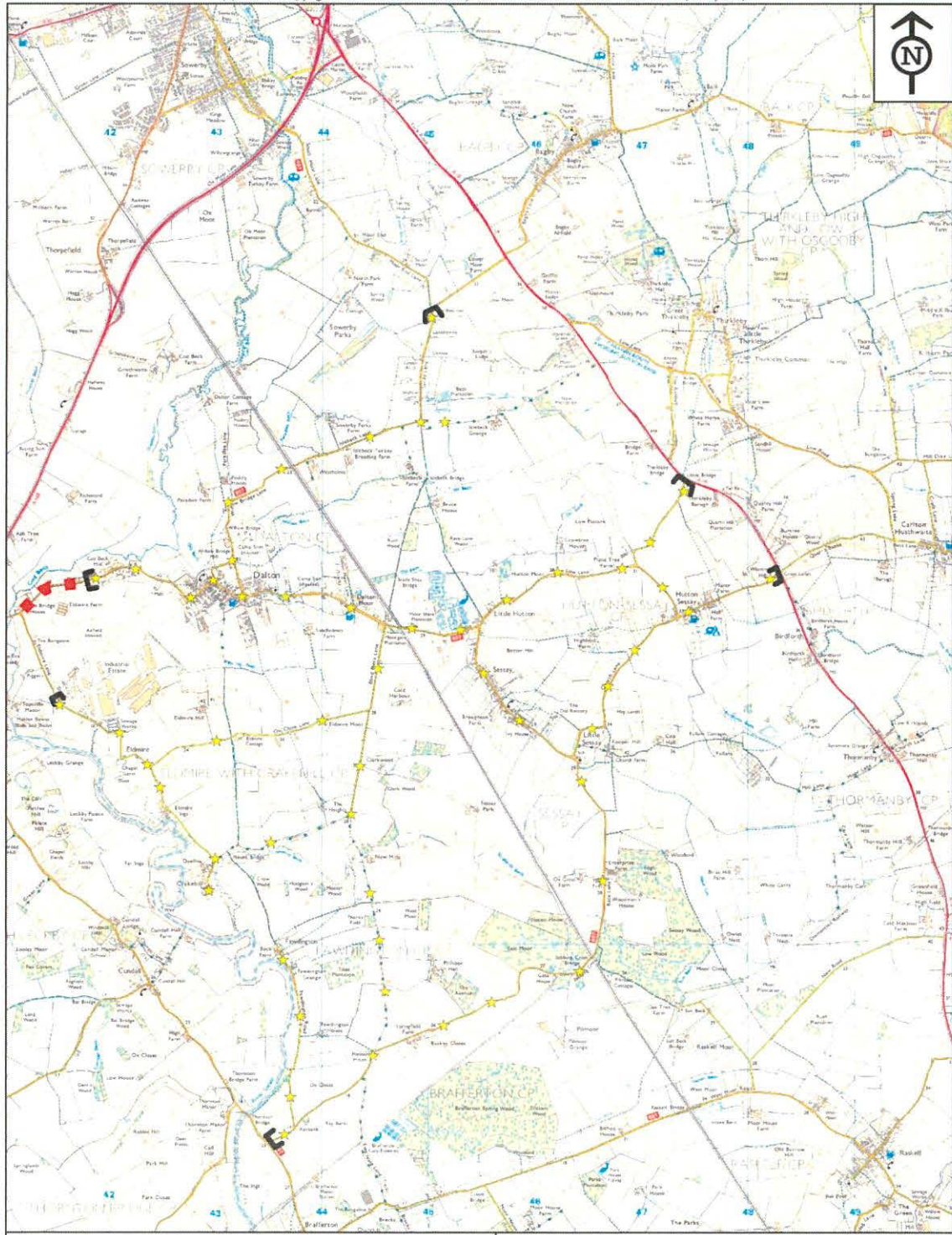

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
