

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION OF HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES) (FOUNTAINS MILL RACE, RIPON)
ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that North Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any heavy commercial vehicle (i.e. any goods vehicle which has an operating weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes) from proceeding along any road or length of road specified below, except for certain permitted purposes which include the conveyance of goods/access to or from premises situated on or adjacent to any of those roads, for the purposes of agriculture on land accessible from and only from any of those roads or for the garaging, servicing or repairing of a vehicle at premises accessible from and only from any of those roads:-

Fountains Lane (C374) from a point 47 metres south of the projected property boundary of Abbey Cottage and the West Gate Entrance to Fountains Abbey, to a point 54 metres south of the projected boundary of Abbey Cottage and the West Gate Entrance to Fountains Abbey. Measured along the eastern channel line of Fountains Lane (C374).
