

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(DISTRICT OF HARROGATE)
(AMENDMENT NO 09) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that on 20 10 2020 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Harrogate) Consolidation Order 2013" by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

SCHEDULE 1

WAITING PROHIBITED AT ANY TIME EXCEPT FOR DISABLED BADGE HOLDERS

Dene Park (U215), Harrogate, South east side, from a point 1.2 metres north east of its intersection point with the projected south western building line of No.39 Dene Park for a distance of 6.6 metres in a north easterly direction (No. 39 Dene Park); Avenue Road (U38), Starbeck, Harrogate, West side, from a point 4 metres north of its junction with Grove Street to a point 10.6 metres north of its junction with Grove Street (2 Grove Street); Main Street (B6164), Kirk Deighton, West side, from its intersection point with the projected southern boundary line of 1 St Mark's Terrace for a distance of 6.6 metres in a northerly direction (No. 1 St Mark's Terrace); Beech Road (U3094), Ripon, South west side, from a point 14 metres north west of its junction with Long Meadows for a distance of 6.6 metres in a northerly direction (No.16 Beech Road); Bridge View Road (U2998), Ripon, North west side, from a point 13.9 metres south west of its intersection point with the projected boundary line of Nos. 8/10 Bridge View Road for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south westerly direction (3 Bridge View Road); Lickley Street (U3029), Ripon, North west side, from its intersection point with the projected south western building line of 23 Lickley Street for a distance of 6.6 metres in a north easterly direction (No. 23 Lickley Street); Skellbank (B6265), Ripon, North west side, from a point 17 metres west of its intersection point with the centre line of Firby Lane for a distance of 3.6 metres in a westerly direction, within the parking layby north of the Skellbank channel line (No.2 The Terrace, 2-4 Skellbank); Wakeman Road (U3086), Ripon, North west side, from a point 5.2 metres south west of its intersection point with the projected boundary line of Nos.7/ 9 Wakeman Road for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south westerly direction (No.10 Wakeman Road); Lupton Close (U3286), Glasshouses, North side, from a point 1.3 metres west of its intersection point with the projected boundary line of Nos.48/ 50 Lupton Close for a distance of 6.6 metres in a westerly direction (No.50 Lupton Close).

North Yorkshire County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Harrogate) (Disabled Person's Parking Bays) (No.4) Order 2016 in so far as it relates to item 7, Schedule 1 (No waiting except Disabled Badge Holders – No. 101 Woodfield Road, Harrogate).
