

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

**(20 MPH AND 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(KNEETON LANE, MIDDLETON TYAS)
(AMENDMENT NO.2) ORDER 2020**

North Yorkshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby order as follows:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour or 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 hereto.
2. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on **[insert date of operation]** and may be cited as "North Yorkshire County Council (20 mph and 30 mph Speed Limit) (Kneeton Lane, Middleton Tyas) (Amendment No.2) Order 2020
4. "North Yorkshire County Council (Various Speed Limits and Derestricted Roads) (Various Roads, District of Richmondshire) Order 2018" is hereby revoked as specified in Schedule 3 hereto.

SCHEDULE 1

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Kneeton Lane - from its junction with the Middleton Tyas Lane north westwards to a point 41.5 metres south east of its junction with the centre line of Kneeton Park (measured along the western kerb line)

SCHEDULE 2

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Kneeton Lane - from a point 41.5 metres south east of its junction with the centre line of Kneeton Park (measured along the western kerb line) north westwards to a point 350 metres north west of its junction with the centre line of Kneeton Park (measured along the western kerb line)

Item 2 – 20 mph Speed Limit, C46 Kneeton Lane
Item 15 – 30 mph Speed Limit, C46 Kneeton Lane.
