

## NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

### (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIOUS ROADS, LAVERTON) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that North Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road in Laverton specified below:-

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	C372 Laverton Road, Laverton	From its intersection point with the U2960 Laverton Village to a point 377 metres north west of the intersection point of the U2960 Laverton Village with the centre line of the C372 Laverton Bridge to Quarry Top, measured along the south west channel line.
2.	Unclassified road U2960 Laverton Village, Laverton	In its entire length
3.	C372 Laverton Bridge to Quarry Top, Laverton	From its junction with the U2960 Laverton Village to a point 190 metres south west of its intersection point with the southern channel line of the U2960, measured along the centre line of the C372.
4.	Unclassified road U2960, East Farm to Warren Lane, Laverton	From its intersection point with the projected eastern property boundary line of East Farm to a point 25.5 metres east of its intersection point with the projected eastern property boundary line of East Farm, measured along the northern channel line of the U2960.
5.	Unclassified road U2959, East Farm to Grey Gables, Laverton	From its junction with the U2960 East Farm to Warren Lane, to a point 19.1 metres north of its intersection point with the projected southern boundary line of East Farm, measured along the western channel line of the U2959.
