CONSULTATION RE. – PIER ROAD AND KHYBER PASS, WHITBY.

PROPOSED BUS STOP AND CHANGES TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The County Council, as Highway Authority for the area, is proposing changes to introduce a bus stop at the bottom of Khyber Pass as shown on the attached plan. The proposal will see the double yellow lines on the corner around the RNLi museum remain unchanged. The bus stop is to be located where there is currently a disabled parking bay but in order to reduce the impact on the spaces available for disabled parking, it is also planned to extend the opposite end of the disabled bay into the permit holders only parking area. The net effect of introducing this bus stop will be the loss of an 8 metre length of permit holders only parking and an 8 metre length of disabled parking.

Secondly, The County Council have received requests to help improve the safety of pedestrians where large vehicles are passing very closely to them. We are therefore proposing to permanently remove some of the less well used loading bays and disabled bays on the narrow stretches of Pier Road.

The Council is required to consult and inform those directly affected by these proposals and the purpose of this letter is to provide you with details of the scheme.

Attached is a simple questionnaire for you to express your views regarding these proposals. **Please return the questionnaires by MONDAY, 31st August, 2018.**

However, if objections are raised which are not resolved or withdrawn, it will be necessary to report them to be considered at the Business and Executive Members meeting to obtain a decision by the Corporate Director of Business and Environmental Services in consultation with the executive members.

The date and venue of any meeting together with conditions regarding public access will be advised, if applicable. I trust this is satisfactory and look forward to receiving your comments.
