(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING) CONSOLIDATION ORDER
2011 (AMENDMENT NO 100) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that on 20 11 2020 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend "The Borough of Scarborough (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) Consolidation Order 2011" by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedules below:-

SCHEDULE 1

EXISTING RESTRICTIONS AFFECTED BY PROPOSED RESTRICTIONS IN SCHEDULE 2

Plantation Hill, both sides, from its junction with Somerset Terrace to a point 14 metres south of its junction with Somerset Terrace – Restriction: No waiting at any time;

Plantation Hill, both sides, from a point 14 metres south of its junction with Somerset Terrace to a point 169 metres south of its junction with Somerset Terrace - Restriction: No waiting at any time.

SCHEDULE 2

LOCATION OF PROPOSED RESTRICTIONS

Plantation Hill, including accesses to Woodend and under Valley Bridge, both sides, from its junction with Somerset Terrace to its junction with Valley Road – Restriction: No Waiting at any time

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 20 11 2020 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
