

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING
(FORMER BUS TURNING CIRCLE – DARLINGTON ROAD, RICHMOND)
(DISTRICT OF RICHMONDSHIRE)
EXPERIMENTAL ORDER

NOTICE is hereby given that on 24 July 2020 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to introduce the following waiting restrictions, for an experimental period of eighteen months:

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 3 August 2020, together with a map showing the road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at County Hall, Northallerton during normal office hours from 31 July 2020 until 31 December 2021 and viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders>. The County Council will be considering, in due course, whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months from the coming into force of the Order, or if the Order is subsequently varied or modified, from the coming into operation of that variation or modification (whichever is the later), any person may object to the making of an Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation.

Any person wishing to object to the indefinite continuation of the Order must state the grounds for their objection, in writing, addressed to **Area 1 Richmond Highways Office, Gatherley Road Industrial Estate, Brompton on Swale, Richmond, North Yorkshire DL10 7JQ** or by email to area1.richmond@northyorks.gov.uk or via the website link above by 3 February 2021.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the above Experimental Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, they may, within six weeks from the date of this Notice make application to the High Court for that purpose.
