

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(DISTRICT OF RYEDALE)
(AMENDMENT NO 14) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that North Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to amend "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of RYEDALE) Consolidation Order 2013" by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedules below:-

SCHEDULE 1

WAITING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES, EXCEPT FOR DISABLED PERSONS' VEHICLES

Southgate, south side, within the marked out bay on the footway, from a point 64 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Vivis Lane, eastwards for a distance of 5 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

**WAITING LIMITED BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8AM AND 6PM TO 10 MINUTES WITH
NO RETURN WITHIN 30 MINUTES**

Southgate, south side, within the marked out bay on the footway, from a point 59 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Vivis Lane, eastwards for a distance of 9.5 metres.

REVOCATIONS

That part of the North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Ryedale) Consolidation Order 2013 that refers to Disabled and 1 number Doctors' parking bay on Southgate, Pickering is hereby revoked.
