

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(DISTRICT OF SELBY) NO 1A ORDER 2021

NOTICE is hereby given that on **19 March 2021** North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, by introducing the restrictions specified below:-

WAITING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES WITH EXEMPTIONS

Sandwath Lane, Church Fenton, West side, from its junction with Station Road to North for 109.5 metres;
Sandwath Lane, Church Fenton, East side, from its junction with Station Road to North for 30 metres;
Sandwath Lane, Church Fenton, East side, between points 60 metres and 80 metres to North of its junction with Station road.

The above proposals were deferred for consideration by North Yorkshire Business and Environmental Services Committee whereupon on 26 June 2020 a decision was taken to allow the proposed waiting restrictions on Sandwath Lane, Church Fenton as originally advertised on 24 October 2019, to be implemented by making a Traffic Regulation Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Order 1984.

The North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Selby) No 1A Order 2021 was hereby made in part under Regulation 19 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 on 19 March 2021. This Order is made in relation to the North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Selby) Order 2020.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on **26 March 2021**, together with a map showing the roads affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton, during normal office hours between 25 March 2021 and 30 April 2021 and also available to be viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders>. If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 19 March 2021 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
