(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (U651 WEST END, SHERIFF HUTTON) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that North Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on the length of road along the road specified below:-

1	U651 West End, Sheriff Hutton	From a point 18 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Castle View, eastwards for a distance of 166 metres.
