ORDER 2020 NO 224

North Yorkshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along Railway Street, Norton Road, Chestnut Avenue, Derwent Road, Seven Street, Ricall Drive and Castle Howard Road, Malton and Westfield Way and Winston Court, Norton-on-Derwent in the district of Ryedale.
2. The maximum duration of the Order will be from 31 August 2020 until 31 March 2021 inclusive.
3. This Order may be cited as North Yorkshire County Council (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Railway Street, Norton Road, Chestnut Avenue, Derwent Road, Seven Street, Ricall Drive and Castle Howard Road, Malton and Westfield Way and Winston Court, Norton-on-Derwent) Order 2020 No 224".
4. Vehicles being used by the emergency services are exempt from this Order.
