(DISTRICT OF RYEDALE)
(AMENDMENT NO 11) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that on 06 11 2020 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Ryedale) Consolidation Order 2013" by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedule below:-

SCHEDULE
PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ALL TIMES, WITH EXEMPTIONS

Vine Street, both sides, from its junction with Commercial Street, to a point 24 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Commercial Street; Vine Street, west then north side, from a point 73 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Commercial Street, to a point 104 metres north and east of the centre line of its junction with Commercial Street; Vine Street, east then south side, from a point 73 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Commercial Street, to a point 113 metres north and east of the centre line of its junction with Commercial Street.
