

**NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(YORK ROAD (A59)
KNARESBOROUGH) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2020**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 21 08 2020 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road at York Road specified in the Schedules below.

**SCHEDULE 1
40mph SPEED LIMIT**

York Road (A59), from a point 180 metres east of its junction with Chain Lane to a point 1467 metres east of its junction with Chain Lane measured along the northern channel line of York Road.

**SCHEDULE 2
REVOCATIONS**

North Yorkshire County Council (Harrogate, Burn Bridge, Pannal and Knaresborough) (Traffic Management) (No 9) Order 2010; Extent of revocation - Schedule 4, 40mph Speed Limit, Item 13 York Road (A59), Knaresborough
