(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(BRIDGE STREET/SLEEGILL)
(DISTRICT OF RICHMONDSHIRE)
(AMENDMENT NO 23) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that North Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to introduce the restrictions specified below:-

No Waiting At Any Time

Bridge Street/Sleegill, North East side, from its junction with Riverside Road to a point 145 metres north west of its junction with the north side of Theakston Lane; Bridge Street/Sleegill, South West side, from its junction with Bridge Terrace to a point 22 metres north of its junction with the centre line of Boggy Lane; Bridge Street/Sleegill, South West side, from a point 15 metres south of its junction with the centre line of Boggy Lane to a point 145 metres north west of its junction with the north side of Theakston Lane (measured along the north eastern kerb line).

No Waiting At Any Time
(Carriageway Only)

Bridge Street/Sleegill, South West side from a point 22 metres north of its junction with the centre line of Boggy Lane to a point 15 metres south of its junction with the centre line of Boggy Lane.
