

## **PROPOSED PROVISION OF WAITING RESTRICTIONS**

### **CARLTON CLOSE/CARLTON WAY CARLTON MINIOTT**

#### **Statement of Reasons**

The County Council as the Highway Authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the Traffic Regulation Order, on one or more of the grounds contained in Section I of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as indicated below:

- (i) For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- (ii) For improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
- (iii) For facilitating the passage on the road of any class of traffic.

The proposal seeks to introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions on Carlton Close/Carlton Way, Carlton Miniott.

At the present time indiscriminate parking is causing an impediment to the free flow of traffic and by introducing the proposed new waiting restrictions it is anticipated that the situation will be improved.

The proposal is as illustrated on "Carlton Close, Carlton Miniott Proposed double yellow lines".
