(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(DISTRICT OF HAMBLETON) (CARLTON CLOSE AND CARLTON WAY, CARLTON MINIOTT)
ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that on 06 11 2020 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Hambleton) Consolidation Order 2013" by introducing the waiting restrictions specified below:-

Carlton Close, Carlton Miniott East - from its junction with the A61 Carlton Road, southwards for a distance of 50 metres.

Carlton Close West and Carlton Way North, Carlton Miniott - from its junction with the A61 Carlton Road, southwards for a distance of 53 metres into Carlton Way.

Carlton Way, Carlton Miniott South - from a point 16 metres north of the southern end of the carriageway of Carlton Way eastwards for a distance of 11.5 metres into Carlton Close.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 23 November 2020, together with a map showing the roads affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton, during normal office hours between 20 11 2020 and 18 12 2020 and also available to be viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders>. If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of [Date Order is made] make application to the High Court for the purpose.
