(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (A63 (Main Street) Monk Fryston)
ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that on 13 11 2020 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road at A63 (Main Street) Monk Fryston specified below:-

A63 Main Street from the last 30mph repeater sign, west for 270 metres.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 27 11 2020, together with a map showing the roads affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton, during normal office hours between 26 11 2020 and 25 12 2020 and also available to be viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders>.

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 13 11 2020 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
