
**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as
amended)**

North Yorkshire Council intends to make this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpath 10.56/42/1,10.56/43/1 and 10.83/14/1 in the Parish of Great and Little Broughton, between grid references NZ53950796 and NZ53150786 for a temporary period of up to six months between 2nd March 2026 and 1st September 2026 due to essential tree maintenance works.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
