

NYCC Joint Plan – Briefing on the ‘Interactive Map’

Data used in the ‘Interactive Map’

- The map comprises of data in three categories;
 1. Oil and Gas Authority PEDL Licence GIS boundary data (publicly available)
 2. GIS Boundary Data for the three Councils (NYCC, NY Moors, York City) (publicly available)
 3. ‘Address Base’ data supplied by ‘Centre Maps’ <https://centremapslive.co.uk/>
- ‘Address Base’ data derives from the Ordnance Survey and comprises a single ‘co-ordinate position’ for ‘buildings’ under a range of classifications.
- ‘Address Base’ classification ‘primary codes’ apply to each ‘co-ordinate position’ as follows:

Chapter 2 Classification codes contained within AddressBase

Primary code	Primary description
C	Commercial Attracts Non Domestic Rates and/or use is of a business nature
L	Land
M	Military Military Defence Site
O	Other (Ordnance Survey only)
P	Parent Shell
R	Residential
U	Unclassified
X	Dual Use
Z	Object of Interest

Presentation of the Map

- The map uses Google Maps as the basis for presenting the data.
- The data has been prepared using standard GIS software, to create the relevant layers.
- Council Boundary Data and PEDL licence areas have been plotted and cropped to the area of specific interest.
- Only building co-ordinates with ‘Primary Code’ ‘R’ within the ‘Address Base’ data set have been used.
- A 500metre buffer zones has been applied from all buildings co-ordinates with ‘primary code’ ‘R’.
- The 500m Buffer Zones are plotted as Grey spheres in the image.
- Areas in green on the Google Maps base are AONB and National Park designations.
