I would just like to raise my concern over the proposal of housing development sites in Monk Fyston/Hillam. I am referring to the plans laid out for: MFRYSTON/002 MFRYSTON/005 MFRYSTON/008 The reason for my concern is that there are many houses overlooking the 'Green Belt' land in this area. I have recently (10/11/2014) moved into a house overlooking this land and had to pay a hefty premium for the view. Additionally, my solicitor did a search and assured me that there were no plans to build behind my property. If houses were built on this land then the value of the surrounding houses will drop significantly and It will most certainly put my house into negative equity. I have seen other more suitable proposed sites in Monk Fryston, for instance one by the main roadside (A63) which should not have a negative impact on the rest of the community. If any of the afore mentioned sites are granted for housing development then I would have not choice but to move and would expect compensation from Selby Council for the drop in value of my house. We as a family have moved out of the centre of a housing estate to find the perfect location with a good school and nice view only to find that this may all come to an end.
