Housing should be limited in Thorpe Willoughby to what is in the planning stage right now, be it full, outline or recently refused/retracted and possibly to be reinstated. I feel that we will have already exceeded our projected growth rate without further large commitments. More should be done to finally develop the former NYCC Old Folks' Home near to the Leeds Road access. A decision should be urgently taken to either demolish the site and build houses on the land, or reinstate as was in order to cater for our ageing population. b) What else is needed in Thorpe Willoughby that could be allocated a site? We have 6 fantastic shops in the village but on the Field Lane site 3 will eventually be replaced by the building of 8 houses, one of the 3 premises being a well used pharmacy. In the 1960's the Orchard Way housing estate was built with the allocation of 3 shops on the site. Why can't any new housing estates being built or future build also have this vital allocation of shops with associated parking being a planning requirement similar to the insistance of recreational open space areas?
