



Escrick Neighbourhood Plan – Information Statement

A Referendum relating to the Escrick Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 6 October 2022.

The question which will be asked in the Referendum will be:

‘Do you want Selby District Council to use the Escrick Neighbourhood Development Plan to help it decide planning applications in the Escrick Neighbourhood Area?’

The Referendum area is identified on the map which is appended to this information statement. The Referendum area is identical to the area which has been designated as the Escrick Neighbourhood Plan Area and covers the parish of Escrick.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum on 6 October 2022 if:

- He or she are entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area; and
- His or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A person’s qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she are entitled to be registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum will be **£2,406.43**.

The number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is **753**.

The Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures similar to those used at local government elections.
